Identity and Residence* - to help ensure that we are able to comply with regulations relating to establishing the nationality and residential status of those intending to marry at a Church of England service; you will need to support your application with documentary evidence to confirm these.

Two separate documents are required as listed below. Please also ensure that the original documents will be available if requested. If you are unable to provide copies of the relevant documents please let us know.

The first is to show that the names stated in your application are correct.

The most convenient method will be by production **of a current passport**. If a passport is used to establish identity, check that it has not expired.

Other acceptable documents are:

- a new style UK/EU photo driving licence,
- a national insurance 'credit card' style document with name and national insurance number
- a birth certificate or Home Office Registration Card with photograph.
- a biometric residents permit (BRP), previously called an identity card for foreign nations (ICFN) was introduced by the UK Border Agency in January 2010 and is acceptable to prove identity.

The second document is required to show the permanent address of each applicant.

The document provided needs to set out the name and full postal address which bears a date no more than 3 months old.

This document can be (for instance) a bank statement, credit card statement, utility bill, mobile telephone contract, council tax demand, rent book, or tenancy agreement.

Please note that a mere letter about any of these matters is not regarded as sufficient.
