Our **Homegroups** are a place to find help and support as we live out our faith - if you are interested in joining a group contact Rev'd Tony Hand.



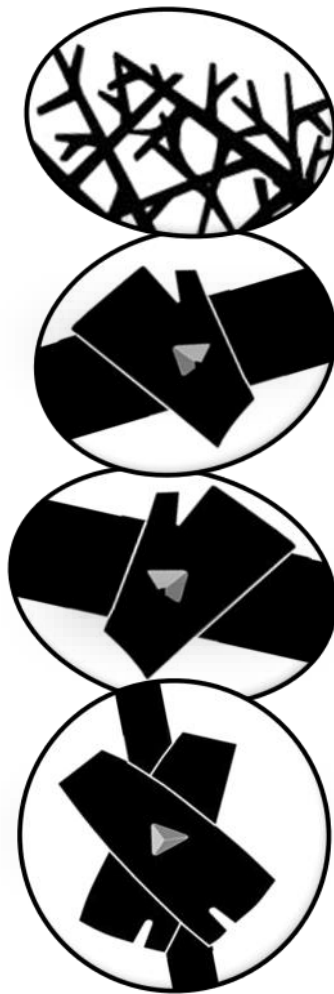

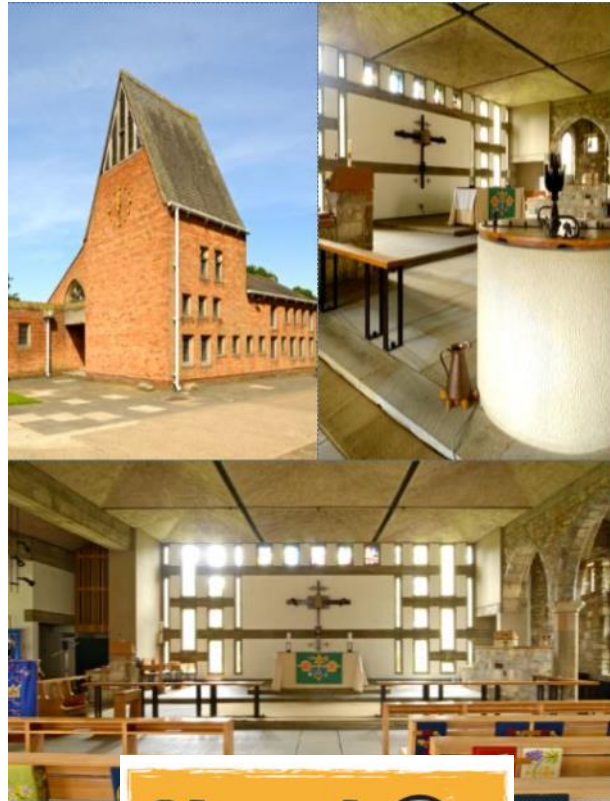
